FIRST COMMUNIONS will be celebrated every Sunday during June, this will bring added pressure on the number of people at Sunday morning Mass. BUILDING WORK: following the disappointment of our redevelopment work, we now need to do some remedial work on the house and church, we also plan to make some improvements to our facilities for the good of our community. We are getting quotations for the work and hope to be able to do it during the summer. NEW LECTIONARY in the autumn of this year the Church in this country is introducing a new lectionary of readings for use at all Masses. It is a different translation, the English Standard Version, Catholic Edition, with the Abbey version of the psalms. We are old it is a more accurate translation of the Scriptures. All parishes are being asked to buy a new lectionary for use at the lectern and other options are also available.
