He was unjustly accused of murder and took refuge on a ship bound for Japan. At that time there was a fierce persecution of Christians there and he was martyred on 27<sup>th</sup> September 1637 his final words *"I am a Catholic and wholeheartedly do accept death for God. Had I a thousand lives, all these to Him I shall offer. Do with me as you please."* Happy feast day to our Filipino community.
