other languages, it will also give you the Daily Prayer of the Church and the Rosary. The app can be bought from [Apps, programs \(universalis.com\)](http://apps.programs.universalis.com) the cost is £19.99, and it can be put on to four devices, so your whole family for one cost. Please buy from Universalis. I recommend this to you, I use it myself for Daily Prayer, for lives of the saints, & much more.
