<u>DEPENDENT PRIESTS' FUND</u> this is the fund that supports priests who are no longer able to work because of illness or because of age who have now retired. These priests have served us well during their lives and now need our support. There are special GA envelopes available this weekend.

SEASON OF ADVENT begins the new Liturgical Year and our reading of a new translation of the Scriptures. We will read from the gospel of St Luke for most of next year and hear his wonderful parables and miracles. Advent is a time of longing and waiting, for the Second Coming of Christ in glory, for the celebration of the birth of Christ in human form in Bethlehem and for his daily coming into our lives through the Scriptures, the Sacraments and the people He has placed in our lives. Use the time well to be aware of God's presence in your life.

There will be a time of **Adoration** each Thursday morning after Mass, I hope you will use this time of prayer during Advent. We will pray for migrants, for peace and for those who are homeless.
