NEW EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS our community needs some new people to serve as Eucharistic Ministers at our Sunday Masses and some who would be able to take Holy Communion to people in their own homes. If you would be willing to do this, please send in your name by email to the parish office. Many of you work shifts, which means that sometimes you have time during the day when you could visit one or two of our housebound people. If you take on this ministry for others, you will need to attend two training sessions before being commissioned to serve as a Minister. Dates for training will be many and varied to accommodate you all around your work commitments.

STANDING ORDER REVIEW: standing orders are the best way in which to support St Michael's Church, if it is possible for you to do this. That is a monthly/weekly payment made direct from your bank to the parish bank on a date of your choice. This means you know how much you are giving, according to your circumstances, and the parish has a regular income. If you pay UK income tax, you can then make your gift worth 20% more by signing a Gift Aid form, enabling us to reclaim the tax already paid by you on your gift, this is a great help to us as it increases your donation without costing you anything. If you do not currently Gift Aid, but do pay UK tax, please ask for a form, it can be completed at church very easily.

After checking the amount being donated in Standing Orders, the weekly amount has now risen to **£520.00 per week**. Many thanks to all who support us through this means of donating.
