### **Diocesan Jubilee 2026 – EA50**

**Bishop Peter:** I am delighted to share more details regarding our main diocesan celebration of the Jubilee Year, that being the Mass marking the Feast of the Dedication of the Cathedral on the 26th of June at midday.

We look forward to a historic celebration with the Apostolic Nuncio to Great Britain, several of my brother bishops, as well as local dignitaries, having already confirmed their attendance.

Our parish has been allotted only 16 members. Those who wish to attend the celebration, please sign the list placed in the GS hall.

### **Day for Life 2026**

This Sunday, 21 June, we mark the Day for Life under the theme “The Wonder of the Child in the Womb.” The theme also recognises the loss of children who died before birth and the grief of their parents. The second collection will go towards the Day for Life Fund, which distributes grants to organisations that promote respect for life from conception until natural death. You can also donate online via the Day for Life website."

### **Magnifica Humanitas:**

Magnifica Humanitas, the first encyclical released by Pope Leo XIV, marks a qualitative leap beyond its predecessors. John Paul II spoke of the media, Benedict XVI of the digital continent, and Francis of the technocratic paradigm and AI at the G7.

Leo XIV integrates AI into the very structure of social teaching, using it as a lens to rethink all its principles — from the common good to social justice.

The real wager is not whether artificial intelligence will ever become human, but whether human intelligence will remain human in the face of the temptation toward absolute performance.

The narrative coup of the encyclical appears in its opening pages, when Leo XIV places two biblical icons at the center of the text: the Tower of Babel and the rebuilding of Jerusalem’s walls in the Book of Nehemiah.
